RELOCATION

Gourmet moves to Loosdorf

Die Gastro-Firma Gourmetschließt ihr Lager in Böheimkirchen und übersiedelt in das Loosdorfer Betriebsgebiet. Die Eröffnung ist für Herbst 2026 geplant.

It's not official yet, but the NÖN (Niederösterreichische Nachrichten) has learned from a confidential source that the catering expert, the St. Pölten-based catering company Gourmet, will be leasing space for its warehouse in the future third building section of the Loosdorf industrial park from Schisernig Real Estate and F&S Real Estate Solutions. Gourmet Managing Director

Herbert Fuchs confirmed the plans to the NÖN. For logistical reasons, Gourmet operates several warehouses at different geographical locations. "One of these camps, specifically the one in Böheimkirchen, has reached its capacity limit due to the pleasing growth of recent years and cannot be expanded any further," explains Fuchs. For this reason, the company decided to relocate from Böheimkirchen and rent a ware-

house in Loosdorf. According to Fuchs, the 30 employees at the Böheimkirchen warehouse have already been informed and will also move to the new warehouse. The new warehouse is scheduled to open in autumn 2026. There will be no changes at the company's headquarters in the

state capital, St. Pölten. „We are very happy in St. Pölten, are continuously investing in the revitalization of the site, and will continue to operate our kitchen and administration there," Fuchs clarified, dispelling rumors.
